## Don't be a Sitting Duck

It is against Landstar's policy for any Landstar leased vehicle (tractor or trailer) to stop or park on the shoulder of any public roadway, except in the case of a true emergency. A true emergency is defined as a situation where the operator cannot go any farther without creating a safety hazard, or causing major damage to the vehicle or cargo. For purposes of enforcement of this policy, the shoulder or apron will be defined as one lane width (11-14') unless defined as a greater width by Federal or State regulatory agencies.

If you must stop on the shoulder of the roadway to call for assistance, follow 392.22 requirements. Triangles and emergency equipment should be properly placed immediately after stopping.

Non-emergency stopping or parking on the shoulder of a public highway will subject the operator to disqualification from driving and/or termination of contract.
